DIRECTIONS TO ELLEY-LONG MUSIC CENTER, 223 ETHANALLENAVE., COLCHESTER, VT

FRI. JUNE 25 8-11pm; SAT. JUNE 26, WORKSHOP 1-4pm, GALA DRESS-UP DANCE PARTY 8-11pm

FROM THE NORTH: I-89 South to Exit 16. **Go right off ramp onto Route 7 South (Main Street to downtown Winooski). At intersection of Route 15 (near Key Bank, Subway, Post Office), go left onto Route 15 East for about 1.5 miles. Turn left at entrance to Fort Ethan Allen (first stoplight AFTER Camp Johnson turnoff), which puts you on Barnes Avenue. ****Take 2nd right onto Ethan Allen Avenue. Go 2/10 mile. On left is sign for Elley-Long Music Center (after the Vermont Public Television building on your right). Park behind Elley-Long building.
FROM THE SOUTH: I-89 North to Exit 15. Bear right off ramp onto Route 15 East. Go 1.3 miles. Follow directions from ** above.
FROM FIVE CORNERS IN ESSEX JUNCTION (intersection of Routes 2A, 15, & 117): Take Route 15 West for 2.3 miles. Turn right at stoplight (note green sign for Civil Defense) into Fort Ethan Allen. This puts you on Barnes Avenue. Follow directions from **** above.

FROM FERRY LANDING IN GRAND ISLE, VT (about 35 minutes): Right onto Route 314 South. Bear left at .6 mile, following 314. Go another 1.6 miles & turn right on Route 2 East. Go 13 miles (look up at 3.2 miles to see Mount Mansfield & Camel's Hump, Vermont's two highest mountains; at 5.5 miles is Sand Bar State Park on left followed by osprey nests on right). Take I-89 South to Exit 16. Follow directions from ** above. *IMPORTANT! WHEN LEAVING ELLEY-LONG MUSIC CENTER:* To avoid confusion when leaving, turn right out of parking lot onto Ethan Allen Ave., then left onto Barnes. This brings you to stoplight & intersection of Route 15.

DIRECTIONS TO PRISCILLA & PETER BURRAGE'S, 16 FOREST RD., ESSEX JUNCTION, VT

FROM INTERSECTION OF ROUTES 289 & 117: Go 117 West. Take 2nd right onto Valleyview Road. ~Then take first left onto Skyline, second right onto Forest, second right onto Rustic and park. The Burrage's is the first driveway on the right after the turn onto Rustic.

FROM FIVE CORNERS IN ESSEX JUNCTION (intersection of Routes 2A, 15, & 117): Take 117 East for 1.3 miles. Turn left onto Valleyview Road & follow directions from ~ above.

FROM ELLEY-LONG MUSIC CENTER OR DAYS INN IN COLCHESTER: From stoplight at Elley-Long entrance (intersection of Route 15 & Barnes Ave.), go 2.3 miles on Route 15 East, staying in right lane to Five Corners stoplight (intersection of Routes 2A, 15 & 117).
